

Different variation of Irish Rose

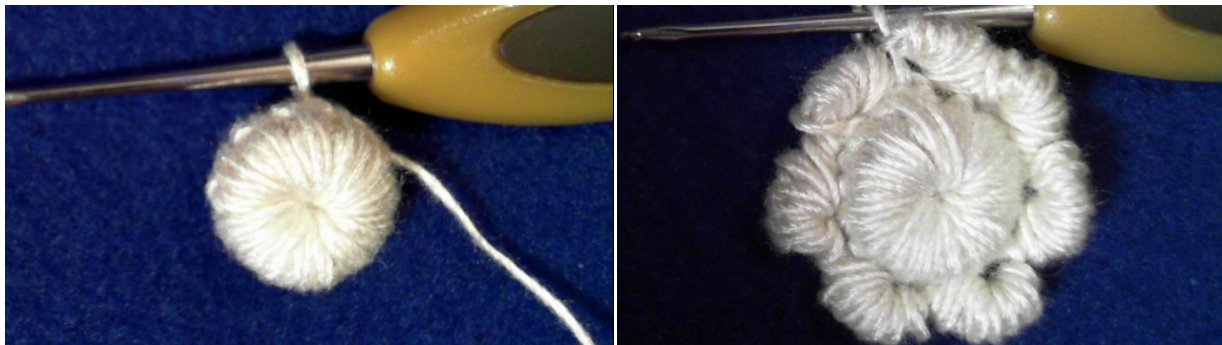
Materials: For this motif I used crochet thread from Aunt Lydia's #10 100% Viscose from Bamboo. This thread is extremely soft, but flowers will look very different if you will use DMC thread. It does not matter what thread to use. The result will be the same.

Crochet hook with Bamboo thread I used #1,25mm.



Make Button.

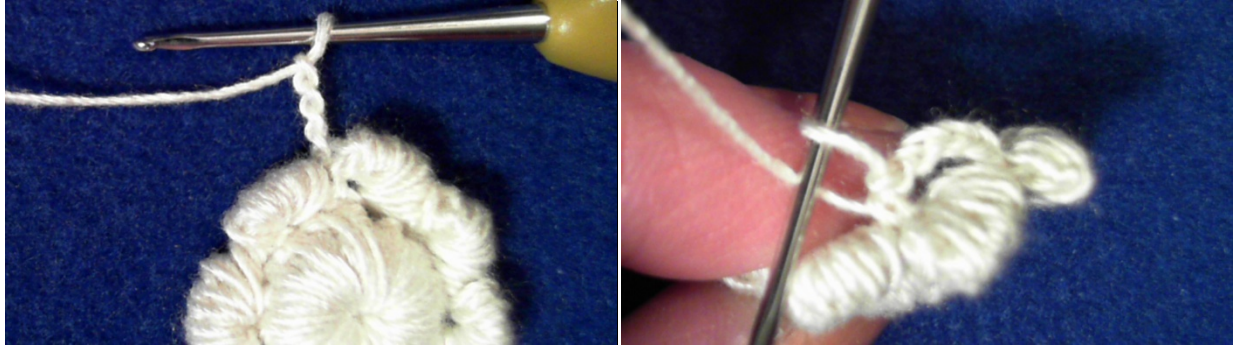
R1: Crochet 7 clones knot sts around the button.



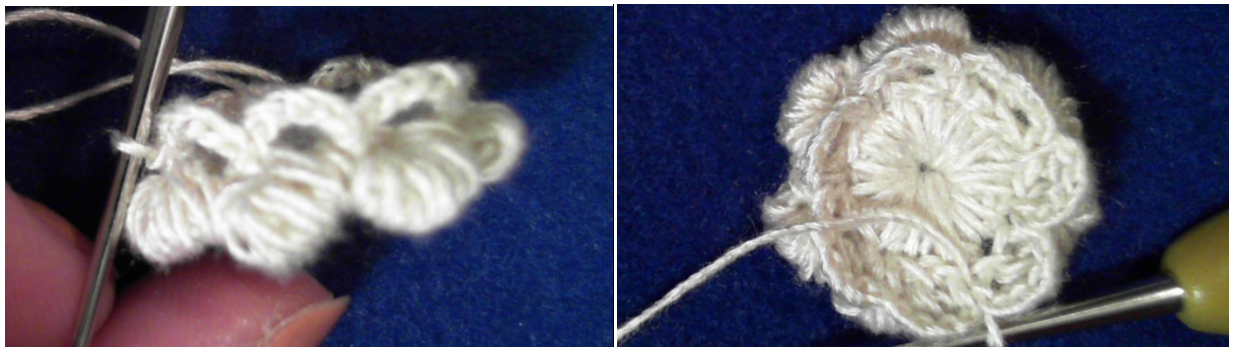
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R2: Ch5; connect to the button with sc st. Connect chains between clones knot stitches.



Again ch5, and connect to the button with sc st. Repeat around the button 5 more times



R3: ch4;

crochet 6trc into the first arch;



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Crochet total of 6 trc sts into each arch;

ch4;



Connect chain to the arch with sl st;

sl st into the next arch;



Ch4. Repeat: crochet all 7 petals the same way as the first petal. At the end of the round make a sl st into the body of a button.



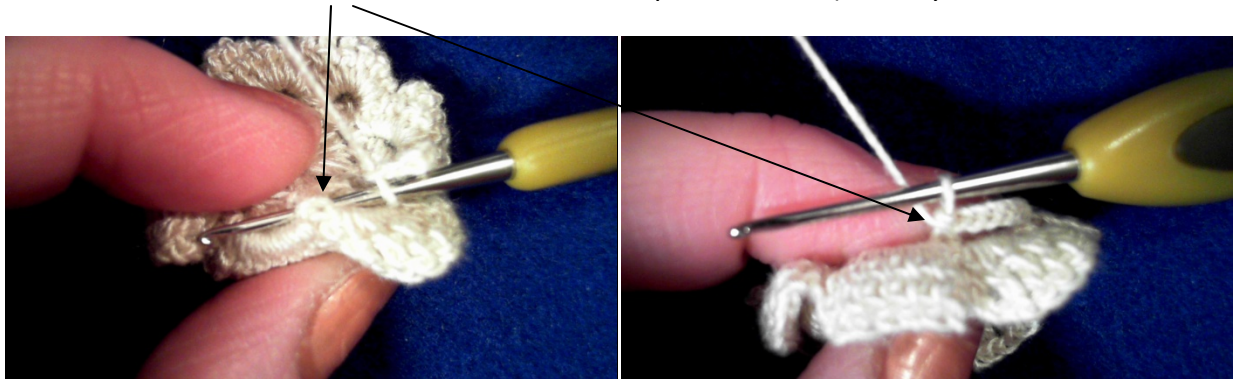
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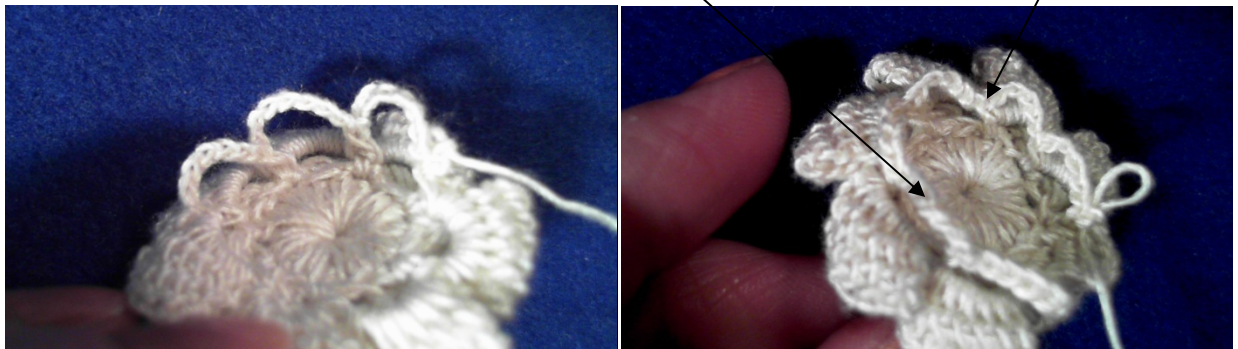
Now you have first layer of petals completed. **R4:** Ch7 (this is your first arch);



Connect chain to the back of the flower with back post sc stitch (where you connected chains



of the second round. Crochet 2 more arches this way (ch7 and connect w/the post st). This round will have two different sets of arches: one with arches equal to ch7; and next set of arches equal to ch5.



So, for round 4 crochet (ch7)3 times, and (ch5)4 times. Connect each arch w/back post sc st between petals.

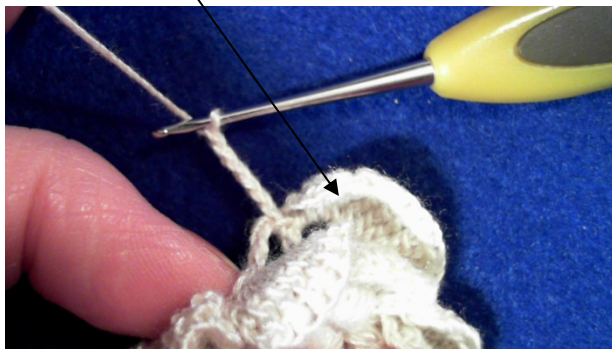
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R5: sc st into the first arch of 7 sts;

ch4;



Crochet 10trc sts into the arch; ch4; connect chain to the arch with sl st. Sl st into the next arch



Crochet two more petals the same way: (ch4; 10trc; ch4 into one arch). Total of 3 big petals.



Continue with the round 5. See next page.

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Sl st into the first arch of 5 stitches.

C h6;



dc in the middle of the first arch of 5 stitches;



ch3;



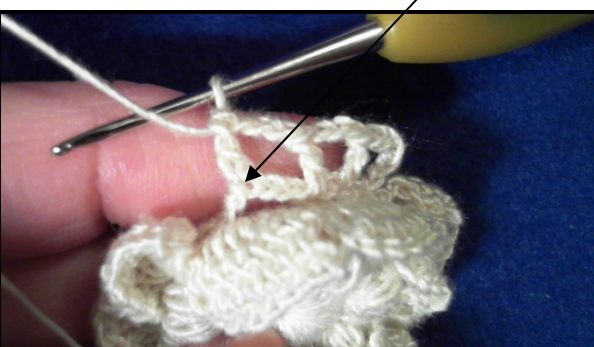
dc between two arches

dc into the middle on the next arch



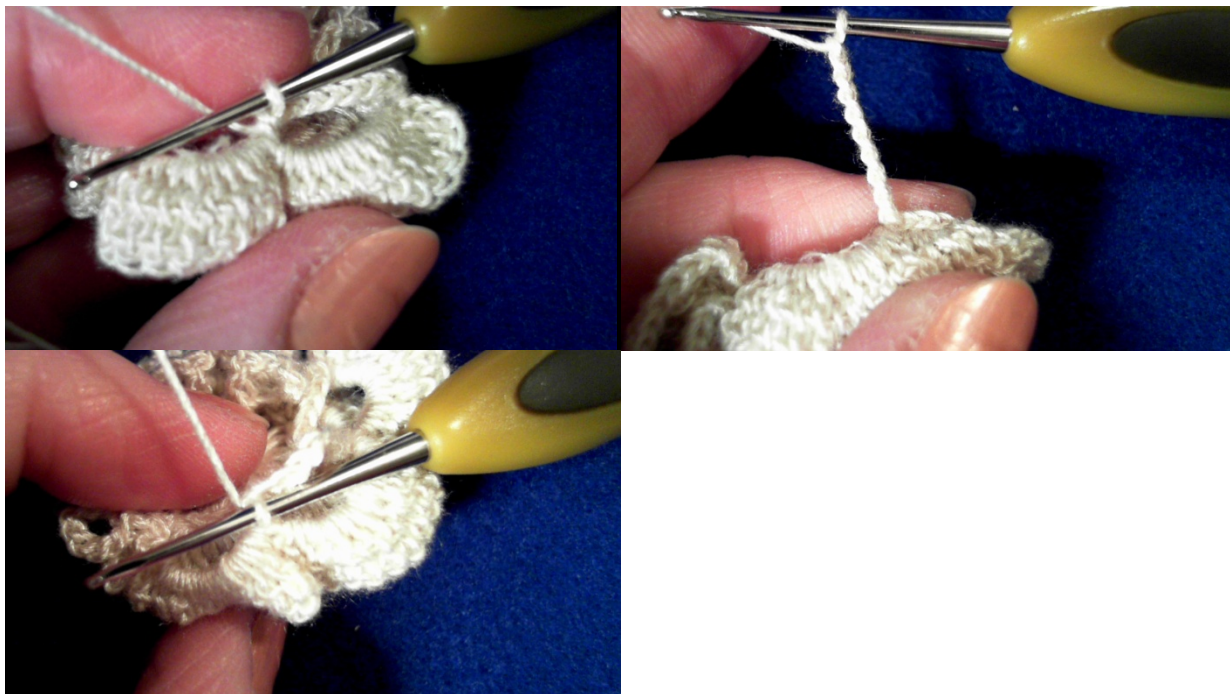
Continue crochet this way to the end of the round 5. Last chain 6, finish the round with sl st.



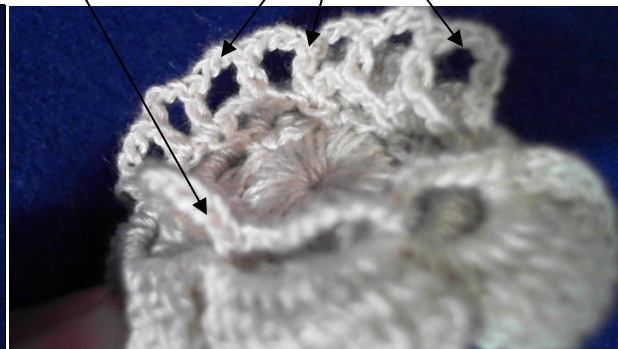
R6: *(ch9;



Connect chain on the back w/ back post st between two petals of the previous row)repeat after
* 2 times.



This is how flower will look on the back: set of 3 arches; and set of small arches.

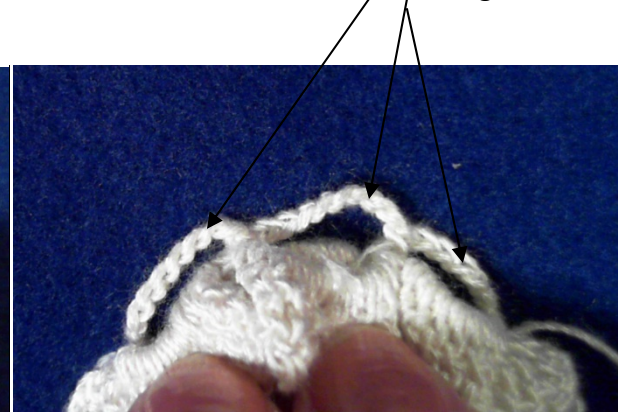
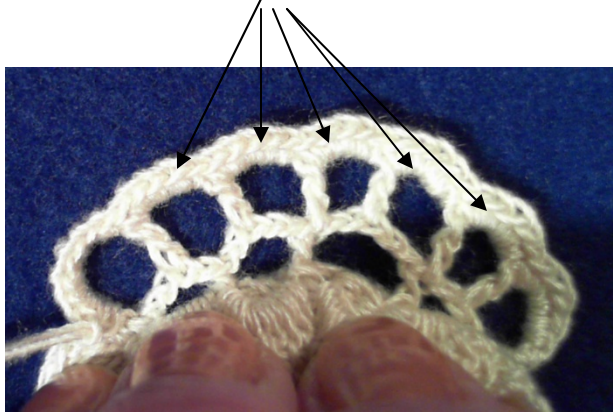


The set of small arches consists of 8 arches. Crochet 10sc into 1st arch and last arches, and



5sc into the next 5 arches.

Now crochet into the next three long arches.



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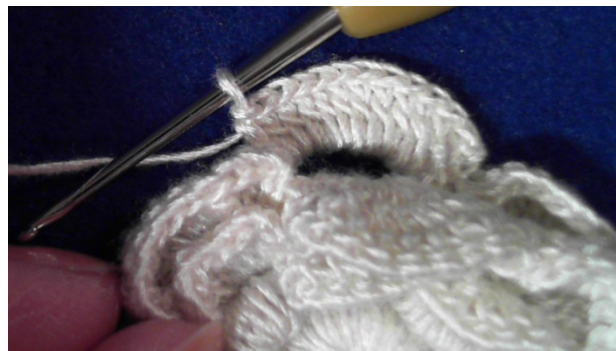
sl st into the first arch of 9 sts.



Ch4;



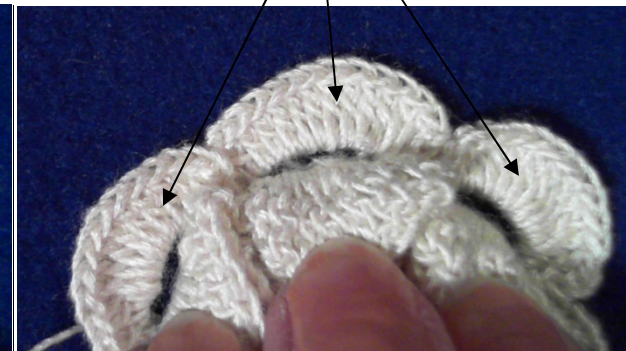
12dc;

Sl st into the same arch. The same way crochet two more petals. Total 3 petals.



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Now when you will fold all petals to see the last Round 6, you can see three big petals, and the set of small arches



Continue crochet **Round 7:**

5sl sts along the first arch;

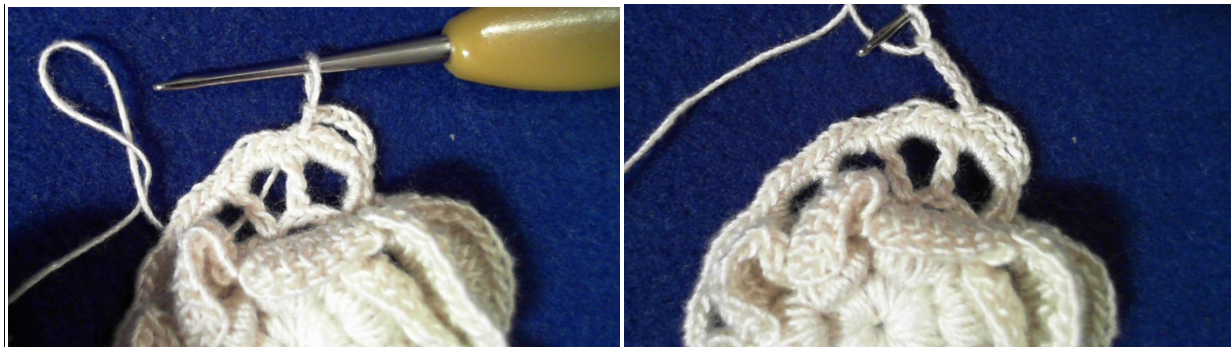
ch5;



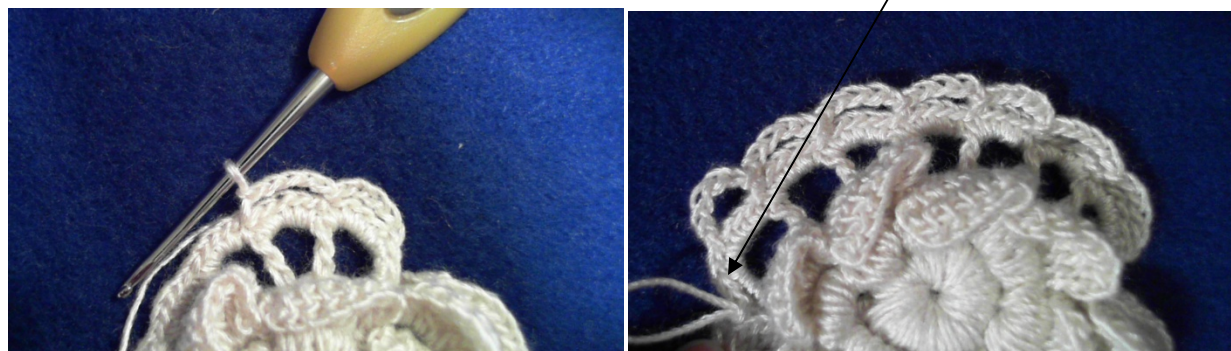
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Sl st between the arches (right on the top of dc); ch5;



Sl st between the arches; repeat to the end. Total of 7 arches. 5sl st along the last arch (on its side)



3sl st along the chain of the first petal. Now we will build up the petals, make them taller.



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Ch4;

15 trc sts spread evenly over dc sts



At the end ch4;



connect chain to the left tip of a petal;

3sl sts along the rest of the petal



The same way crochet the rest two petals. This is how they will look.



Now it's time to crochet over the small arches.



3 sl sts into the place where you were crocheting sl stitches once before, it is like climbing up to the first arch.



Crochet into each arch: hdc; 5dc; hdc. Crochet sl st between the arches. Finish the round with sl st, cut thread, weave in end.



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
